A woman is eligible for recommendation by a local chapter if she:

Is a citizen or legal permanent resident of the U.S. or Canada

- Is enrolled in a certification or degree program from an accredited institution;
 has not already earned a master's degree or above
- Is living and studying in the U.S. or Canada for the entire course of study
- Has had at least 24 consecutive months as a nonstudent sometime in her adult life
- Is within 18 consecutive months of completing her educational program
- Is enrolled in an education program which, at the conclusion of, will lead to employment or job advancement

PSA Eligibility Requirements

P.E.O. Scholar Award

Competitive - \$20,000 Grant

A woman is eligible for nomination by a local chapter if she:

- Is a citizen or legal permanent resident of the U.S. or Canada at the time of her nomination
- At a minimum, has a bachelor's degree
- Is within two years of her graduation date and has at least one full academic year of work remaining to complete her doctoral-level degree as measured from the time the first award payment is made (August 1). Those in a multiple-degree program (e.g.,pursuing both an M.D. and a Ph.D.) must be with in two years of completing the entire program from that date.
- Is enrolled in her program at an accredited U.S. or Canadian college or university. Study abroad is permitted provided the student is enrolled in a U.S. or Canadian postsecondary institution.
- May be enrolled part-time or full-time
